

The Physician Assistant (PA) Program at Radford University is accredited by the AR students to sit for the Physician Assistant National Certifying Examination (PANCE) Certification of Physician Assistants (NCCPA). All states require that an initial license will need to meet the mental, physical, and ethical requirements/attestations for checks; and sponsoring physicians and/or institutions, practice agreements, and are reported for licensure. If licenses have been held in other states for provision of notification of any disciplinary action will be requested. Upon licensure, PAs will be medical education and NCCPA certification. DEA licensure is a separate application with additional requirements for prescriptive authority imposed by some states. Countries are as follows:

State	Other Requirements
Alabama	Declaration of Citizenship with supporting document
Alaska	Alaska Statute 08.01.060(b) requires an applicant for an occupational license to provide a United States social security number. Clearance report from the Federation of State medical Boards Clearance Report from the Drug Enforcement Administration.
Arizona	Documentation of citizenship or alien status that conforms to A.R.S. § 41-1080.
Arkansas	All applicants and supervising physicians will be required to appear together before the Physician Assistant Advisory Committee prior to licensure. Proof of citizenship, naturalization, visa or work permit. Copy of Driver's License or Passport Copy of DD Form 214, if you have been released or discharged from any branch of the U.S. Armed Forces at any time during or since Physician Assistant School.
California	Request a self-query from the National Practitioner Data Banks (NPDB) website at www.npdb.hrsa.gov. The self-query report will be mailed to your address. When you receive the report, mail (do not fax) the original report to the Board office.
Connecticut	No less than 60 hours of didactic instruction in pharmacology.

Delaware	<p>Request a self-query from the National Practitioner Data Banks (NPDB) website at www.npdb.hrsa.gov. The self-query report will be mailed to your address. District of Columbia	Three letters of reference from PA or MD who have personal knowledge of the applicant's abilities and qualifications to practice as a PA
Florida	Applicants for initial licensure must use a Livescan service provider to submit a set of fingerprints to the Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) for

Hawaii	Required Federation Discipline Report to be sent directly to the Hawaii Medical Board.
Idaho	May require personal interview with applicant and/or sponsoring physician
Illinois	Must also file notice of employment prior to practice; Requires notice of prescriptive authority to be submitted by each supervising physician
Indiana	Requires a notarized copy of your diploma; May not submit for prescriptive authority until 1800 hours of practice have been completed; Chart review and supervision requirements for each year of employment in any practice

Kansas	Must complete an active practice request form. Required recommendation form from a peer.

Louisiana	Successful completion of online course and exam concerning rules and regulations for practice in Louisiana
Maine	Required to pass a Jurisprudence Exam
Maryland	Required proof of oral and written competency in English; Required completion of a Delegation Agreement

Minnesota	Practice Location Notification form must be submitted within 30 days of licensure in MN
Mississippi	Required actual copy of diploma; Required in person interview; Required to pass a Jurisprudence Exam; Must be at least 21 years old
Missouri	May require in-person interview with Board. National Practitioner's Data Bank Self-Query required; Required to pass a Jurisprudence Exam
Montana	The Board will request a report from the NPDB about each applicant and obtain DEA information directly
Nebraska	Temporary 1 yr license available without PANCE
Nevada	Proof of identity; High school transcripts required; 4 hr of bioterrorism CME, and 2 hr suicide prevention/awareness required; Required to pass a
New Hampshire	Must have a NH-licensed physician accepting supervisory responsibility
New Jersey	CV required; Proof of identity; Military service profile, if a veteran
New Mexico	Two professional recommendations required; May require personal interview
New York	Evidence of training in infection control and barrier precautions. May obtain "limited permit" to practice pending PANCE passage
North Carolina	Three professional references required; Federation Credentials Verification Service (FCVS) can expedite credentialing and has a different application
North Dakota	Contract with a supervising physician required
Ohio	Masters or higher degree required; Onsite supervision of initial 500 hours required for prescriptive authority
Oklahoma	Pass a Jurisprudence Exam provided by the state with at least 75%; Required extended background check
Oregon	Required open-book completion of the Medical Practice Act Exam
