

Endowed and Annual Scholarship Guide for Donors

Establishing an endowment or an annual scholarship is an act of generosity that allows Radford University to attract and retain the very best students, regardless of financial need. More than 60 percent of our students receive some form of financial aid and scholarship support is an essential part of this assistance. Scholarships can be based upon financial need and/or merit. You may establish an endowment or an annual scholarship to honor a loved one or memorialize an important person in your life. Regardless of the type of scholarship you decide best meets your goals, a member of the Advancement team will work with you to write a Gift Agreement that ensures your scholarship is awarded according to your wishes while meeting the needs of our students.

Definition of Scholarship Types

Endowed Scholarship

An endowment is a permanent gift that is an investment in the future of Radford University and our students. A portion of the annual earnings of the endowment are used to fund the scholarship. On average, you can estimate 4% of the endowment is generated annually and will fund your scholarship. Actual payout distributions are reviewed annually and will be determined based on the Radford University Foundation's spending policies. You may fund your endowment with a single gift or multiple gifts spread over time. Once the endowment reaches \$25,000, it will be eligible for awarding in accordance with the spending policy set by the Radford University Foundation. Should you prefer to have your scholarship awarded before this time, you may make an annual gift to fund the award.

Annual Scholarship

An annual scholarship is a current-use gift that allows your donation to be used in its entirety. The fund is viable only as long as you continue to make annual contributions. This option gives you flexibility to assist a student on an annual basis. To maximize the impact, we hope you will make a multi-year commitment to your scholarship.
