General Recommendations

- Individual instructors identify an assignment that fulfills the learning outcomes and complete a rubric in the LMS
- Students complete the assignment as part of their regular course work
- Instructors grade the assignment using their normal scoring criteria as part of the students' class grades.
- One rubric for each learning outcome in the LMS
- Assessment is not the same as grading.
- Data privacy/anonymity important
- Policy issues in place at beginning
 - o Faculty-driven process about assessing teaching and learning
 - o If anyone is identifiable in any way, data are not included in the output
 - Data go directly to the General Education Program
 - Faculty cannot be evaluated using their individual assessment reports
 - o Individual instructor reports will only be provided to the instructor
 - Departments/schools will not be required to generate assessment reports
 - Program-level reports will be publicly shared on General Education program web site
