WHAT Come dressed to move and play. We will play “Mad Libs-style” improv games and be reading from the script.

Bring your complete class and work/life schedule from October 7 through November 21.

Bring your headshot and resume if you have those. Audition forms will be completed upon your arrival at auditions.

SOUGHT Energetic, creative, and fun performers to create the world of Judy Moody’s mind. The roles are:

Judy Moody, an assertive and resourceful third grader with powerful emotions

Stink, Judy’s curious and impulsive younger brother

Mom/Cap’n Mom, Judy and Stink’s helpful, firm, and fun-loving mother

Dad/Pegleg Dad, Judy and Stink’s accommodating and enthusiastic father

Tall Boy, clever and eager third grader-turned-treasure hunter

Smart Girl, focused and crafty third grader-turned-treasure hunter

Scurvy Sam, a pirate dedicated to the remembrance of Black Beard the Pirate

Four-six ensemble members for Treasure Hunters, Students, Gramma Lou, etc.

OTHER There is no stage intimacy as such but performers will work in close proximity to one another—lifting each other, creating inanimate objects with their bodies, etc. Consent and respect for actors’ boundaries will be a foundational part of the rehearsal and performance process.

Also important: This production’s run contains a series of school day performances requiring cast and crew to miss morning and *possibly* early afternoon classes Friday, Nov. 15 through Thursday, November 21. So, students with solid academic records will be strongly considered in casting.

ALL Radford University students are eligible to audition regardless of their major.

This is a very fun play so come prepared to share that spirit of fun and wonder and your talents!
